HOW TO MAKE A FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION TO THE PARISH

We now have a number of cashless donation systems in place to make it safer and easier to make a financial contribution to the parish:

- The best way is to set up a Standing Order with your bank. There is a form on the parish website you can either print off, fill in and take to your bank or use to get the parish bank account details and set up a Standing Order on your bank's website or app.
- After Mass you can use your bank card or smartphone/watch to make a donation using our card machine. Just ask a Steward on your way out.
- Go to the parish live-stream page via the parish website and use the donation button.
- Download a QR Code reader to your smartphone and scan the QR codes located by the wooden collection box (see below). This will take you to a website where you can use Apple Pay, Google Pay or input your bank card details. There are eight QR codes to choose from giving you an option of £3, £5, £10 or £20 and the option to Gift-Aid your donation if you are a UK Taxpayer.

PLEASE ONLY USE CASH <u>IF YOU ARE NOT ABLE</u> TO USE ANY OF THE CASHLESS SYSTEMS ABOVE.

<u>Gift Aid</u> – From now on you will find Donation Envelopes on your seats in church. <u>Please only use these envelopes to make a donation to the parish</u>. In order to use them efficiently, please do one of the following options:

- If you are a Gift-Aider, i.e., if you normally make a donation using Gift Aid envelopes, simply write your Gift Aid number where it says 'Envelope No' and place the envelope with your donation inside in the wooden collection box in church.
- If you are not a Gift Aider, but you are a UK taxpayer, please complete all the information on the envelope and tick the Gift Aid box so that your donation can be Gift Aided and we can contact you about becoming a Gift Aider, then place the envelope with your donation inside in the wooden collection box in church.
- If you are not a UK taxpayer, please do not use the envelope at all, simply place a cash donation in the wooden collection box in church or use one of our electronic donation platforms such as card donations, Standing Order or via the parish website.
